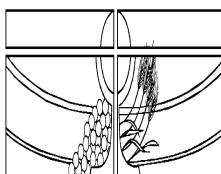

FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

As we gather for Mass this weekend there seems to be a contradiction. Jesus is preparing his disciples for his departure—"I will be with you only a little longer" - and yet we know that he is present with us even today. His presence is manifest in so many ways: creation, each other, especially the needy, in his Word, and most significantly, in the Holy Eucharist: his Body and Blood.

I guess I wonder if we are confused at times or add to the contradiction? Do we really believe him to be present to us when we enter a church and see the bright tabernacle door shining or the red sanctuary lamps indicating his presence. Is the church a place like no other for us as we come into the Real Presence of Jesus? That's why we dress appropriately or check our cell phones more than once before entering. Our encounter or audience with Jesus is the reason we try to rid our minds of those things that can be a distraction.

This communion with Jesus is one of the reasons he asked us to celebrate the Eucharist in his Name: "Do this in memory of me." For close to twenty centuries now the faithful—Catholics like you and me— have done precisely that Sunday after Sunday. This Saturday forty-two children from our parish received Holy Communion for the first time. I pray that today, Sunday, all forty-two will receive Holy Communion for the second time. In doing so I hope that they like all of us will understand that Jesus is still with us— especially in his Sacred Body and Precious Blood.
